ALL ENTRIES

- Entries for club competitions must be submitted by the submission date, unless special dispensation received from Competition Secretary
 - Entries submitted must not have been previously entered in same competition

PRINTS

- Entries for print competitions should be mounted with mount sizes not exceeding 20x16 inches / 50x40cm
- All submitted prints must have a completed club sticker on the rear of the print.
 (Available on the website @ http://www.earlshiltoncameraclub.org.uk/competition-labels/) Please put the sticker on the back bottom left of your print, giving the image Author, Title, Competition and date of submission.

PROJECTED IMAGES (PDI)

 Images may be submitted on Memory Stick or by email to the Competition Secretary and match the specified standards: File type: JPEG; Colour Space: sRGB; Maximum Image Size: 1920 pixels wide by 1080 pixels high. Resolution: 72dpi

(Note: Portrait format images should be no more than 1080 pixels high)

Filename: Should be "<image title> - <authors name>.jpg" only.

The Competition Secretary will add a two-digit number to the front of the filename in order to simplify slideshow production

MONOCHROME IMAGES

- Monochrome photos contain variations of only one colour and nothing else. This could be different shades of one colour, e.g., blue, green, or grey etc.
 - Note: Black & white is monochrome but monochrome is not limited to black & white see (expertphotography.com/monochrome-vs-black-and-white-photography/)

COLOUR IMAGES

- All images other than those meeting monochrome criteria above are defined as colour images
- A black and white image which has been modified by the addition of partial toning or by the addition of one colour to any part of the image is a colour image

COMPOSITE IMAGES

- All components of a composite image must have been taken by the author, this also applies
 to added textures and skies.
- Composite Entries for TWUKL should be taken at same location

NATURE IMAGES

- Images where living organisms are the primary subject matter.
- The story telling value of an Image will be weighed more than the pictorial quality.
- Processing of the image, by cropping, exposure adjustment, colour correction, noise
 minimisation, dodging/burning, HDR, focus stacking, mono conversion and sharpening, is
 permitted, as is cloning of image defects and minor distractions including overlapping
 elements. An Image appearing to meet these criteria will be accepted as Nature. If in
 doubt consult PAGR rules




